Dear Bill and Peter,

We requested various witnesses to provide affidavits. Attached are copies of those (eight) which are finalized and which we are providing to the Committee prior to the hearing so they may review them as they choose.

We have attached an affidavit from Dr. Lohnert (which is not notarized) because it is difficult to obtain such a notary (in Germany), and one from Dr. Nigmatulin, who said it would be very difficult to get it notarized in Russia because of procedures which must be followed. He, of course, will testify live (assuming travel does not become an issue).

You and Mr. Selander discussed similar notary issues with regard to JaeSeon Cho, who is in Korea. I believe you agreed with Mr. Selander that this should not be a problem. We anticipate providing an affidavit from Cho shortly.
